Starting School

Children may start at our school in the Autumn Term of the school year in which they will become five years old. Parents and Carers of children entering school for the first time will be contacted by the school in order to arrange a suitable time for visits. We encourage new intake children to come and join us for a series if afternoon visits in the term before they start school. We also make provision for new Reception children to have a short "phased" in period into school. This will be in consultation with Parents and Carers and is on a "needs" basis for each child. It is anticipated that all children will be in school full time by the first term break in the Autumn - with most children being full time after the first two/three weeks in school.

We strongly believe that the needs of each individual child are paramount at the start of their school life.

As a Community School our Admissions Policy is determined by the Local Authority. We are phasing towards becoming a 3 form entry Primary School - eventually having places for 630 pupils. Our Reception intake is set at 90.
