

Read Write Inc., developed by <u>Ruth Miskin</u>, provides a structured and systematic approach to teaching Reading. It is used by more than a quarter of the UK's primary schools and is designed to create fluent readers, confident speakers and willing writers.

Our school uses:

Read Write Inc. Phonics for our children from Reception to Year 2 and for our children in Years 3 to 6 who are new to English. Children rapidly gain the knowledge of different sounds and graphemes; learn to blend and begin to

apply these phonics skills to read stories.

Read Write Inc. Spellings for Years 2 to 6, which has been specially created to meet the higher demands of the national curriculum. Using child-friendly characters, children learn new spelling rules and patterns and practice these words daily.

Years 1 to 6:

Talk for Writing, developed by Pie Corbett, enables children to imitate the key language they need for a particular topic orally before they try reading and analysing it. Through fun activities that help them rehearse the tune of the language they need, followed by shared writing to show them how to craft their writing, children are helped to write in the same style.
