Cladding on our School

It is absolutely understandable that concern is heightened regarding external cladding in light of the Grenfell Tower tragedy.

The cladding on our school is a completely different product rated to European standard EN13501-1 certified and approved to B-s1, d0.

B-s1, d0:

B = Inflammable Materials

\$1 = Very limited Smoke Development

D0 = No Burning Droplets or Particles

Our premises are also fitted with a comprehensive fire detection system, we have good systems in place regarding the evacuation of the premises which can be achieved within minutes and the fire department should reach site within seven minutes so the cladding should have no impact on life or significant spread of fire.
