

Maths

Place value: we will looking at counting forwards and backwards from any number to 50 and counting in multiples of 2's and 5's and 10's.

Addition and subtraction: we will continue to learn our number bonds and related addition and subtraction facts to 20, add and subtract one digit number and two digit numbers, use the correct symbols and solve one step problems

Measurement: we will learn to measure length, weight and volume, using non-standard and standard units of measure

Art/ D&T

We will be looking at the work of notable artists, JWM Turner and Richard Dadd, and saying how it makes us feel. We will also be using felt to create a fairy tale character.

Geography

We are going to identify the four countries that make up the United Kingdom and locate these on a map. We will also be using digimaps to locate the capital cities of each of these countries. We will continue to keep a weather chart to answer questions about the weather and changing seasons.

PE We will be partaking in swimming sessions for a course of 10 weeks with Swim Well. In school, we will be focusing on Dance during Spring Term 1 and move on to Team Games in Spring Term 2.

Science

Investigating Materials: We will be identifying different material, distinguishing between the object and the material from which it is made. We will describe the simple properties of everyday materials and compare and group together materials according to their properties.

Seasonal Change: We will continue to observe changes across the four seasons.

History

We will be looking at how our lives are different to those from the past, focusing on using different sources such as artefacts and pictures. We will be looking closely at castles from the Middle Ages and their purpose in History.

English Phonics: We will be building on our phonic knowledge, focusing on Phase 5 from Letters & Sounds.

Guided reading: We will read a selection of fiction and non-fiction texts, and answer associated comprehension questions.

Writing: We will be writing for a range of purposes focussing on Fairy tale stories, including Cinderella, Three Little Pigs, Little Red Riding Hood and Billy Goats Gruff.

Computing We will be using Digi maps to locate capital cities of the UK. We will be using a Paint program to create a shield.

RE

We will be learning about Judaism and visiting a Synagogue to learn more about their customs

Music The children will be using Charanga and instruments to improvise and compose music, focusing on 'In The Groove' and 'The Banana Rap.'

PSHE We will be focusing on 'Dreams and Goals' and 'Health Me.'

We will be continuing to answer questions using simple greetings and phrases.
