
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Last week, we were beginning to subtract two single digit numbers (e.g. 6-2=). We are becoming confident using the language of subtract, take-away and equals. This week, we have been learning about capacity. We are beginning to use the language: full, half full and empty. We have explored filling and emptying containers with pasta and rice. Next week, we will be focussing on our Maths interrail targets.





In Literacy, we have been completing independent writes to show how fantastic we are at writing without support. We used the story of 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' to write simple sentences or label the characters. Next week, we are focussing on their reading skills. We will continue to practise segmenting and blending words, reading small captions and beginning to read sentences.

Last week, we introduced the story 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. The children have enjoyed taking part in different activities based on this story. They have drawn pictures of the characters and labelled them and created their own bears using mixed media. We created our very own story maps to help us remember parts of the story when retelling it.

This week, we have made porridge and added our own toppings including honey, raisins, banana and apples. We tasted it to see if we liked it lots of us enjoyed it so much they finished a whole bowl! We are looking at changing parts of the story, this week we changed the character.







We have also discussed different jobs and what the children would like to be when they grow up. We then thought about what skills we needed to develop to help us with that job in the future.

In PE, we have started using the apparatus and have explored different ways of travelling across a bench.

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If your child would like to bring in one of their favourite books for us to read during story time at the end of the day then we are happy to read them, however, please can you ensure they are named to avoid anyone losing their book.

Please continue to supporting your child/children with their reading, their Red words and Maths Inter rail targets as this helps to secure their knowledge.
