Y4 Residential Croft Farm 27th April 2022– 29th April 2022

The Year 4 residential visit for 2022 is Croft Farm in Tewkesbury from Wednesday 27th - Friday 29th April 2022. Residential visits are designed to provide fun activities for pupils, which may not be available to them ordinarily. We hope to take as many of our children as possible to help make it a memorable time.

The cost of the visit will be £189 for two nights. This has been heavily subsidised by the school in order that as many pupils as possible are able to access this experience. The cost covers travel, food and accommodation as well as activities.

We are aware that this is a large sum of money to find so we are happy for you to pay off as much as you can afford each week/month. We do, however, require a £30.00 non-refundable deposit from each child so we can confirm the booking by 31st October. This deposit will secure a place for your child. Our method of payment is by Parent Pay. If you require a Parent Pay log in, please contact the school office.

Everyone will need access to ParentPay to give electronic permission, we are not asking for slips to be returned, including those who are entitled to FSM. You are able to give electronic permission without making payment.

Please note the suggested payment dates and amounts for instalments, although you can pay at any date prior to the final due date:

31st October 2021	Deposit due	£30.00

31st January 2022	Payment 3	£30.00
28 th February 2022	Payment 4	£30.00
31st March 2022	Payment 5	£30.00
30th April 2022	Payment 6	£39.00

If you are in receipt of free school meals (FSM) the school will contribute the full cost of the trip from the money provided by the Government. Please note free school meal entitlement has to be applied for and is not offered to everyone.

Please note; in line with the provider's policy we have to charge for cancellations on a sliding scale:

69 – 29 days prior to departure: loss of 60% of the total trip cost for the individual

28 - 15 days prior to departure: loss of 80% of the total trip cost for the individual

14 – Departure day: loss of 100% of the total trip cost for the individual
