We have started to settle into life in Year 1 and are currently doing more formal learning sessions across English, Maths and Quest. Although it has taken some getting used to, the children are taking on the challenge like STARS.

In English the children are learning the story of the Three Little Pigs. We have put actions to the story and created a story map to help us remember it. We have taken out the big bad wolf and replaced him with an equally formidable animal, like a lion, bear or fox.

In Maths we are looking at Place Value. The children have been working out what one more than and one less than a number is and recognising and ordering numbers both sequentially and non-sequentially from smallest to largest and vice versa. Over the next few weeks we will progress onto order numbers and finding one more and one less.



In Science we have started to identify and describe materials, such as metal, wood and plastic. We are looking at what objects are made of and why a type of material is more suitable for that job.

In History and Geography, we have looked at why castles were built and where different castles are located in England.
