Here we are at the end of Term 4, moving very quickly towards Spring and Summer.

We sincerely hope – like all of you - that the national restrictions will be lifted and that we can look at returning the school to it's normal ways of working. However, at the moment the restrictions that we have in place are to remain, as schools are under different restrictions. Schools have to follow DfE guidance which will continue to come out through April and May. Face coverings, social distancing, the one way system, start and end times of the school will remain.

I continue to be proud of the staff and children at Calton and how they have adapted to the changes since returning on the 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021. I have given out many new Head Teacher Awards for positive attitude to learning – none of this could have been done without the support from you as parents.

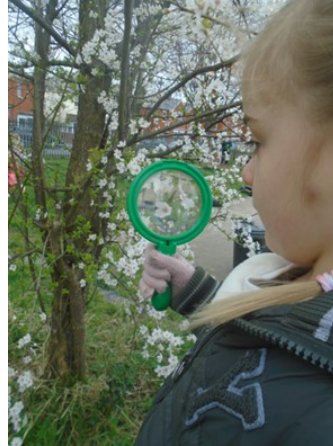
