Important information for Consultation Evenings:

• Entry and exit will be via the front of school but we request that you are mindful of others when coming in and leaving

- Masks MUST be worn inside (we would also request that Lateral Flow Device Testing has been carried out prior to coming on-site but we will not check)
- Once in the meeting it will be agreed in a mutually convenient way between teachers and families as to whether masks will be worn
- Unfortunately books will not be available to be looked at as this would prolong time on-site (teachers will have them in the meeting to discuss)
- We request that each family has a maximum of 2 people attending
- Timings will be kept as tight as possible to minimise the amount of people around
- We will aim to keep rooms as Covid safe as possible and staff will sit at least 2 metres away from you

We understand that not everyone will wish to come into the building. If you wish to have a phone call consultation instead of a face - face meeting, this can be arranged with your child's Class Teacher separately.


