I hope that you all had a good half term? Like all half terms these are times to take stock and spend time with each other. I do hope that you managed to get some time together as a family?

You would have all heard on Monday 22nd February, from the Prime Minister, that all primary aged children can return to school full-time on Monday 8th March. We are absolutely delighted that we can welcome all children back to school at last for face to face teaching. We know that this has been a difficult time for children and families both in educational and social terms, so the return is very timely.

Since the announcement on Monday the Senior Leadership Team and some Governors have worked hard to ensure that all children and their families return to school safely. I can assure you that the timings for the school day have remained the same which is: 8:40 - 9:00am drop off and 3:00 - 3:20pm collection for primary aged children. There will be some changes which I am finalising today and will update you very shortly. I am

sure that you are aware that things take time and a great deal of preparation, so I ask that you are patient as we want to ensure that we get this right.

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We understand as parents the pressures that you are under and as school staff we are facing this too. However, can we kindly ask that when you do call into school and speak to the admin staff you do this courteously. This is also the same if you are leaving a voicemail message. We do have limited admin staff in the office, particularly towards the end of the week.

Thank you to all those families that have sent in work that the children have completed. I am absolutely amazed at the level and completion of work from stories to cooking to 3D models. Please look on our Facebook page as we update this very frequently with the amazing work that we receive.

On a final note, if you have not yet made a parent consultation appointment, please can we ask you to contact the Class Teacher through the Year group email.
