Important information needed urgently – Key Workers

We are developing our contingency plan for Monday 23rd March and beyond and need to be aware of the number of children who may need to attend school as their parents' key worker role stops them being able to stay at home.

Reason for school closures

It is important to remember the reason for school closures: to minimise social contact and therefore reduce the potential for the spread of the Coronavirus. So, whilst parents may be key workers, actions should be taken to avoid school attendance unless this is necessary even from this group.
