

Maths -

Place Value: We will practise counting forwards and backwards from any number to 20 and focus on ordering, comparing and one more and one less.

Addition and Subtraction: We will start to learn number bond facts and related subtraction facts to 10 and 20. We will solve addition and subtraction number sentences and solve one step problems.

Geometry: We will look at 2D and 3D shapes and understand their properties.

Science/ DT - We will learn to identify everyday materials, their uses and properties. We will make 3D houses for 'The Three Little Pigs' using different materials. We will carry out an investigation to see which house is the strongest by observing, recording and evaluating.

Music - As part of our Christmas production we will learn a number of songs off by heart and perform them for an audience.

PE - We will be using a dance unit called 'The Three Little Pigs' to explore space and movement and direction. We plan to develop the ability to tell a story through our actions and expressions.

British Values -

We will learn the names of the main Royals and create a family tree for our own families.

We will look at the national flags of Britain and how they make the Union Jack.

RE - We will be learning about what it means to belong to a community, and start to explore what Christians believe God is like.

Art - We will be creating our own beads from clay and threading them to create jewellery. We will also manipulate the clay to create shields and embellish them with jewels and patterns.

MFL - We will learn how to count and say key phrases in French. We will practise answering the register in different languages.

English -

Reading: We will read a selection of fiction and non-fiction texts, and answer associated comprehension questions. We will continue to build on our phonics knowledge in Read Write Inc sessions.

Writing: In English we will focus on four key texts: The Three Little Pigs, Little Red Riding Hood, Tell me a Dragon and the Jolly Christmas Postman. We will use these stories to create setting and character descriptions and practice applying our phonic knowledge.

Geography/ History - We will be exploring castles through-out the United Kingdom and looking at their purpose and location. We hope to visit a local Castle to help understand its features.

Seasonal Change - We will be taking weekly photographs of the allotment throughout the academic year to track how our environment changes.

PSHE - We will start by thinking about our place in the classroom, and what we want it to be like. Then we will explore relationships and how we treat our family and friends.
