Maths -

Place Value: We will practise counting forwards and backwards from any number to 50 and focus on ordering, comparing and one more and one less.

Addition and Subtraction: We will start to learn number bond facts and related subtraction facts to 20. We will solve addition and subtraction number sentences and solve one step problems.

We will start looking at measurements including length, height, weight and volume.

Science/ DT - We will be making Gruffalo Crumble linking to our topic and we will hopefully be hosting a stay and sew. We will classify and identify animals, including humans, and start to look at the parts of their body. We will carry out an 'Eye test'

Music - We will be using both 'In the Groove' and 'Round and Round'. We will do both singing and instrumental lessons. We will also look towards improvisation.

PE - We will be looking to create a gymnastic sequence of movements. We will look at different types of jumps, including pike and tuck, rolls, ways of moving and positions.

British Values -

We will learn and discuss the British values of Tolerance and Mutual Respect, linking this in with our RE lessons.

Oh No! It's a ...

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RE - We will be learning about Judaism and linking this to our British Values. We will also be looking at the Easter story and What Christians believe about Easter.

Computing/ Art -We will be looking at the work of William Morris, saying what we like and dislike about it. We will then look at making different pencil marks before making patterns of our own.

MFL - We will learn the names of different animals in French. We will also revisit answering the register and counting in French.

English -

Reading: We will read a selection of Julia Donaldson texts, and answer associated comprehension questions. We will continue to build on our phonics knowledge in Read Write Inc sessions.

Writing: In English we will focus further on Julia Donaldson texts: The Gruffalo, Charlie Cook's Favourite Book, Smeds and Smoos and Monkey Puzzle. We will use these stories to create our own character and practice applying our phonic knowledge to writing adjectives.

Geography/ History -In History, we will start by looking at the life of Julia Donaldson. We will then look at what school was like in the past and compare these to school days now. We will also compare our own childhoods with Julia Donaldson. We will also link in our Art and look at the History of Axel Sheffler before sketching the Gruffalo based on his illustrations.

PSHE - We think about our goals and dreams. We will then be looking at celebrating our differences. We will also be creating our own self portrait.

Special Events - Julia Donaldson Dress up Day, World Book Day.
