Year 2 – Indigo, Magenta and Turquoise Class

In English, we wrote our own biographies about Roald Dahl using research we collected about his childhood, employment and significant achievements. We have now started to look at the language features we need to use when writing an adventure story. This will help us when writing our own sequel based on Charlie and the Chocolate Factory over the next few weeks.

In Maths we have been learning about fractions. We have practised finding fractions of shapes, quantities and sets of objects. We have also learned about equivalent fractions and how 2 quarters is the same as 1 half. We will now be learning about length and height. We will practise measuring different objects using cm's and m's, compare and order lengths and solve problems based on length.

Before half term, we enjoyed carrying out a gymnastics intrasport competition where we had to work as a tea to put together a sequence. These contained balances, jumps, rolls and different ways of travelling.



In Science, we were introduced to our new science topic. We discussed what we already know about plants and generated questions that we would like to find out. We then carried out some research using iPads about plants to find out about what they need to grow, examples of plants and the parts of a plant. We also went on the iPads in computing to learn about what makes a good photo. We used an online photo library and searched for images of plants. We then discussed what makes a good photo and what the word 'photography' means.
