English

In English we will use the books 'How to be a Superhero' by Sue Fliess and 'Superhero Hotel' by Abie Longstaff to help us write for different purposes. We will create our own superheroes, write a superhero narrative and create a brochure explaining how we can be superheroes in real life. We will also create a newspaper article about real life superheroes. In Guided Reading we will share a wide variety of texts linked to our theme.

PSHE

We will learn about the routines, rules and expectations for Year 2 and discuss our hopes and worries for the upcoming year. We will discuss how we can feel safe and happy in our class and how we can reconnect with our friends.

RE

We will be looking at the religion of Islam and understanding Muslim beliefs and ways of living.

Music

We will use 'Charanga' to explore music genres. We will listen to, appraise and learn the lyrics of a song called "Friendship".

Art/ DT

We will design and create our own superhero costume. We will also learn about how we can consume a healthy diet. During our Enterprise Week, we will carry out market research to help us to design and make our own healthy snack.

British Values

We will look at the significant achievements of real life superheroes. We will discuss the important jobs and roles people have in our community.

Maths

We will develop our understanding of number and place value, including partitioning tens and ones. We will learn the different strategies to help solve addition and subtraction number sentences. We will also revise and consolidate maths fluency skills in our Maths Inter-Rail sessions.

Science

We will identify plants in the school grounds and learn about the plant life cycle and what plants need to survive. We will grow our own radishes in the allotment and monitor their growth. We will also carry out investigations on effective handwashing and the best material for Traction Man's cape!

Computing

We will practise turning on laptops, logging in and opening programmes. We will use Bee-Bots and the programme 'Scratch' to create and resolve faulty algorithms.

PE

We will practise PE key skills including running, jumping, hopping, skipping, throwing and kicking. We will play team games to consolidate our catching and throwing skills.
