We have really been enjoying our topic this term!

In Maths we have looked at money and how to write different amounts using pounds and pence, adding amounts together and calculating change. We are also beginning to explore statistics including pictograms. We will also look into bar charts and tables.

In English we have continued with our narrative writing skills, including the DumSpiro text. We have been working really hard to innovate and create paragraphs for our stories, ready to write it all using an introduction, a problem, a solution and an ending.

In Science we have continued our exploration of magnets. We worked in small groups with magnets and a variety of objects and we tested to see what objects are magnetic. As we made predictions before testing, some objects really surprised us!

In Computing we have been researching different aspects of Roman life. We worked in small groups to research facts and create a mind-map on a variety of topics including, Roman myths, jewellery, food, clothing and important people.

We also thoroughly enjoyed our recent trip to Caerleon to visit the Roman remains including the barracks, baths, museum and amphitheatre. We learnt so much about the Romans and we were able to try on lots of armour! Having reflected on our trip, it has really developed our understanding of how the Romans once lived in the UK.
