As Historians we will begin by looking at who the Romans were and how Rome started. We will then focus on the expansion of the Roman Empire and find out who Boudicca is! We will investigate what everyday life was like for Romans before looking at the descent of the Romans and the legacy they have left for us.

As Mathematicians we will be investigating Roman Numerals. We will focus on this legacy through solving different calculations and problems using the four operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division!

As Athletes we will practise and display our footwork with ball games. We will then move on to practising our Gymnastic skills and create sequences using different types of movements.

As Artists we will be investigating Roman Mosaics and making our own! We will create our own Roman Army shields and make a clay bust.

As Language Speakers we will begin to learn some Spanish vocabulary and Latin commands.

The Rotten Romans!

As Musicians we will be learning Let Your Spirit Fly and Ho Ho Ho - paying attention to the tone, pace and tempo.

As Geographers we will be looking at the cities the Rotten Romans conquered! We will also focus on capital cities, the seas and the Northern and Southern Hemisphere.

As Writers we will be studying Roman Myths to then write our own. We will also be writing our own Newspaper Reports on the explosion of the famous and destructive Mount Vesuvius! We persuade why the Roman ruling system is the best and write information leaflets for our museum.

As Scientists we will be investigating the difference between rocks, and how fossils are formed. We will also be looking forces including magnets.



In PSHCE we will be using the Jigsaw scheme, exploring friendships groups and how to be positive in a negative in a range of situations.
