

Maths

Place value: we will be looking at counting forwards and backwards from any number to 20, identifying one more and one less as well as using a number line and counting in multiples of 2's and 5's.

Addition and subtraction: we will start to learn our number bonds and related addition and subtraction facts to 20, add and subtract one digit number and two digit numbers, use the correct symbols and solve one step problems

Shape: we will recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes and describe position and movement including quarter, half, three quarter and whole turns.

PE

We will be developing our interpretive dance skills, making use of the space around us, facial expressions and storytelling. We will also be developing our Gymnastics, including rolls and balancing to put into a short routine.

Geography

We are going to develop a clear understanding of what human and physical features are within our environment and apply this knowledge to a computing project.

RE

We will be learning about what it means to belong to a faith community and what Christians believe God is like.

Music

The children will be using Charanga to create music to identify different sounds and begin to create sounds with both our voices and different instruments.

History and British Values

We will be investigating how things have changed over time in our own lives, as well as looking at the life of Julia Donaldson.

Art and D&T

We will be investigating repeating patterns and the work of William Morris which will inspire our own repeating patterns. We will also develop and make a hand by joining materials together.

English

Writing: we are focussing on Julia Donaldson books including: 'The Gruffalo', 'Highway Rat' and 'Monkey Puzzle'.

Science

We will be identifying different types of animals and learning all about them as well as identifying and naming parts of the human body and understanding the five senses. We will be asking questions, observing and classifying different animals and begin to gather information and record data.
