

We have had a busy few weeks in Year 3!

In English we finished our persuasive texts about visiting Gloucester and we have moved onto learning about Hans Christian Andersen's fairy tale, 'The Little Matchstick Girl'. The children have story-mapped and planned their own version, which they have been really keen to write! We have put lots of work into including adjectives and description in our writing.



In Maths we have continued looking at addition and subtraction. We have started adding tens and ones using column addition and we have now moved onto subtracting ones using column subtraction. We have all focused on making sure we show our workings out!

We have continued learning about Plants in Science and have looked at the life-cycle of a plant, how seeds are spread and how water travels through a plant. The children loved setting up their first experiment using celery and food colouring to see how the water travels through it!

In Geography we have continued learning about the different Biomes of our planet and we have created some wonderful posters about deciduous forests. We have also learnt some key facts about the two main rivers in Gloucester and Kasur, Pakistan; the river Severn and the Indus river.

In English we will finish writing our own Fairy Tale and we will move on to learning about Poetry.

In Maths we will be continuing with addition and subtraction and using the written methods to help us with this.
