What we have been learning

<u>English</u>

Year 4 have started to look at non-chronological reports now in English. First we identified features of a non-chronological report and we read a text about magnets and innovated it ready to write up our paragraphs next week. We have looked at what makes a good paragraph which we will now use in our non-chronological writing.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths, we are now looking at addition and subtraction. First we were adding 4 digit numbers with no exchanges and then we moved onto addition with exchanges. Now we are going onto subtraction without exchanges before moving onto subtraction with exchanges.

<u>Quest</u>

We have carried on learning about electricity which is helping us in our nonchronological reports. We carried out an experiment to show which materials are conductors and insulators. In geography we have looked at the different layers of the rainforest and what animals and vegetation we might find there. In PE we had a visitor come in to teach us gymnastics. In PSHE we learnt about roles and responsibilities in the school and why each role is important. In RE we have written prayers of thanks ready for our harvest festival which we will start practising for next week ready for our harvest assembly at St Barnabas Church in the final week of term.
