Dear Parents/Carers,

Extra – Curricular Clubs Summer Term

We are very pleased to be offering various extra-curricular clubs within our school, as this enables our children to learn skills to become part of a team, achieve their goals, show respect towards their peers and relish in the success of completing a club at our school. Please refer to this letter and the chart overleaf, for all the information regarding these clubs.

Each club will be starting during the week beginning **Monday 9th May**. Clubs will run until week ending **Friday 8th July**.

Clubs this year are running after school, children can only choose a club which is available to their year group. They will begin straight after lessons and finish at 4.15pm for Key stage 1, and 4:20pm for Key stage 2. If your child has been successful in gaining a place in a club, they will be sent home with a slip including the details of the club.

The chart attached along with this letter shows information on where to pick your child up from. **Please collect your child promptly at the directed time and pick up location.**
