Maths –

Place Value: We will practise counting forwards and backwards from any number to 10 and focus on ordering, comparing and one more and one less.

Addition and Subtraction: We will start to learn number bond facts and related subtraction facts to 10. We will solve addition and subtraction number sentences and solve one step problems.

Science/ DT - We will learn to identify everyday materials, their uses and properties. We will use this knowledge to help find Captain Calton a suitable outfit to help him stay dry when flying through rain.

Music - We will use the theme music from popular superhero films and analyse it. Looking at the different instruments, finding the pulse and discussing what we like/don't like.

Geography and British Values -

We will learn about the four countries of the UK, their flags, capital cities and national symbols.

RE - We will start to explore what Christians believe God is like.

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Key Vocabulary – atlas, map, capital city, materials, strong, waterproof, absorbent, reflective, pulse, countries, united, symbol, relationships, collage.



English –

Reading: We will read a selection of fiction and non-fiction texts, and answer associated comprehension questions. We will continue to build on our phonics knowledge in Read Write Inc sessions.

Writing: In English we will focus on two main text: Juniper Jupiter and Traction Man. We will use these stories to create setting and character descriptions and practice applying our phonic knowledge.

PSHE – We think about our relationships and how we treat our family and friends. to achieve, and the steps to do it.

PE – We will be developing our fundamental skills, ensuring that we have mastered the basics before progressing further.

MFL – We will learn how to count and say key phrases in French. We will practise answering the register in different languages.

Art -We will be looking at collage this term, including the work of Ben Giles Lewis. We will combine our collage skills with Science and Geography through out the term.
