

What a busy start to the term! We have loved having the children in full time this week and they have coped really well with the school routine.

We have started Read, Write Inc and we have been learning a sound a day. The children have been writing their sounds in sand, shaving foam and lots of other resources. We have also been practising our handwriting. We have talked about how to sit smartly and how to hold our pencils. We have also been practising writing our sounds in the sand and lots of other materials!



The sounds we have covered this week are m, a, s, d and t. Please ask your child which sound they learn each day. Each Friday we will send home the week's sounds so you can practice at home.

In Maths we have been working on our counting and number recognition skills. We have been counting anything and everything! We have focused on careful counting strategies encouraging the children to touch each object and to count slowly.



We have also started PE. For our first PE lesson we only changed our socks and shoes. Next week we will be changing into our full PE kits.
