Maths -

Place Value: We will practise counting forwards and backwards from any number to 50 and focus on ordering, comparing and one more and one less.

Addition and Subtraction: We will start to learn number bond facts and related subtraction facts to 20. We will solve addition and subtraction number sentences and solve one step problems.

We will start looking at measurements including length, height, weight and volume.

Science/ DT - We will be making Gruffalo Crumble linking to our topic and we will hopefully be hosting a stay and sew. We will classify and identify animals, including humans, and start to look at the parts of their body. We will carry out an 'Eye test'

Music - We will be using both 'In the Groove' and 'Round and Round'. We will do both singing and instrumental lessons. We will also look towards improvisation.

PE - We will be looking to create a gymnastic sequence of movements. We will look at different types of jumps, including pike and tuck, rolls, ways of moving and positions.

Computing - We will develop the skill of searching for specific animals pictures on the internet and saving them into a presentation. This will link nicely with our Science as we show case our knowledge of animal groups.

RE - We will be learning about Judaism and linking this to our British Values. We will also be looking at the Easter story and What Christians believe about Easter.

Geography/ History -In History we will be comparing what life was like in the past, we will think about, school, toys, music, homes and entertainment. This will help us to develop vocabulary and also help us to become brilliant historians as we develop inferencing skills.

In Geography we will be learning about human and physical features.

British Values - We will learn and discuss the British values of Tolerance and Mutual Respect, linking this in with our RE lessons.

Art - In Art we will be exploring different mark making techniques. This will help us to develop fine motor control! We will also look at the work of the illustrator, Axel Scheffler.
