As we start the new half term we are beginning to think about how we measure in different ways using non-standard measures. We are thinking about how we can use measures to compare and assess what we are doing. We started with a scientific hypothesis which we set out to explore. We had a lot of fun measuring different parts of our body using cubes to see whether the distance between our elbow and wrist is the same as the length of our foot. We wonder whether yours is? We recorded our results on a class chart.



In D and T and English we have designed our own finger puppets and written the instructions to make them. We had our grown-ups come in to help us make them using sewing, which we thoroughly enjoyed.

In PE we have been measuring and counting our activity results and trying to improve our skills. We worked with a partner to practise throwing, running, jumping and hopping. We found the hopping very tiring.

In Maths we will continue to look at different measures and how we use them. We are looking forward to World Book Day and dressing up as our favourite character.
