Year 3 have been learning lots of exciting new things about our theme 'Rotten Romans'.

In Maths we have started to look more at the written method for multiplication and used it to multiply a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number. We have also started looking at division and using our times tables to help us divide a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number without remainders.

In English we have continued with our story about "DumSpiro". We have created story maps and actions, innovated our own narrative story and started writing our own version!

In Science we have continued learning about forces and magnets. We have investigated how a toy car moves on different materials after being pushed and what items around our classrooms are magnetic.

In Art we have sketched a portrait of ourselves as Romans using half of a photograph and have started looking at a local artist. We gave our opinion on different pieces of his work and then tried sketching a portrait in his style.

We have also worked as a team in our PSHE lessons to design a garden decoration and we presented our ideas to the rest of the class. In computing we have started our own research about the Romans so that we can make a PowerPoint presentation.
