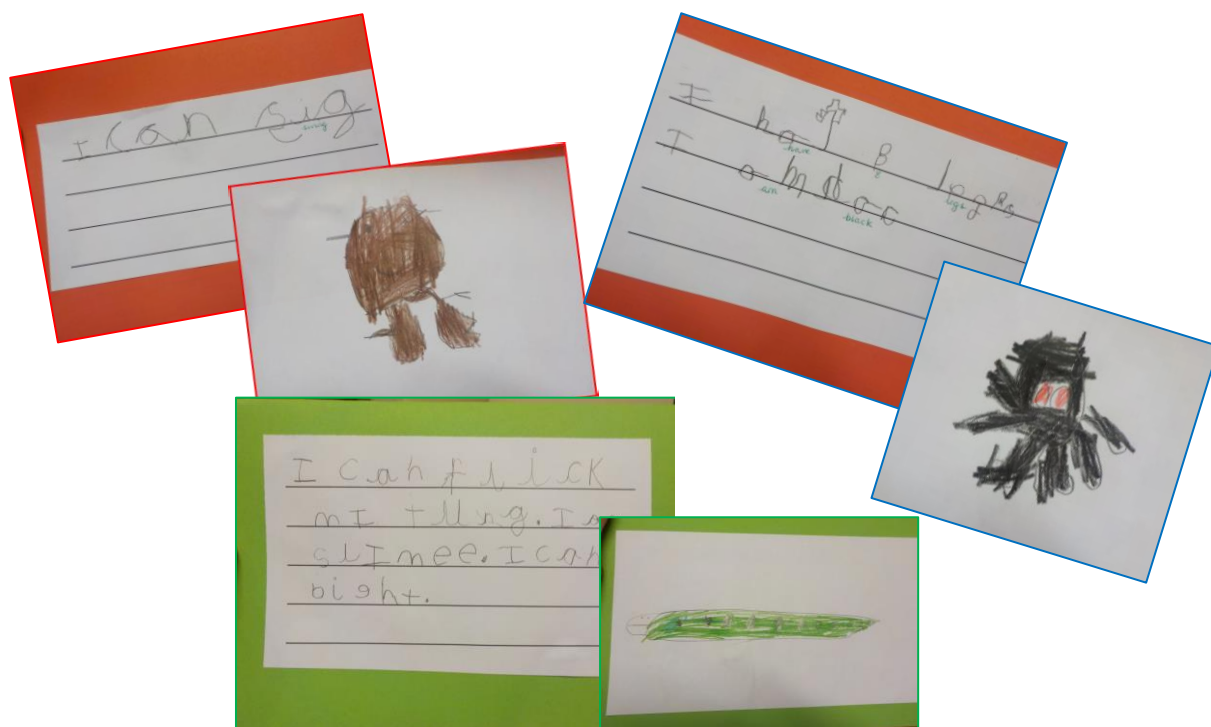


## 10<sup>th</sup> May 2019

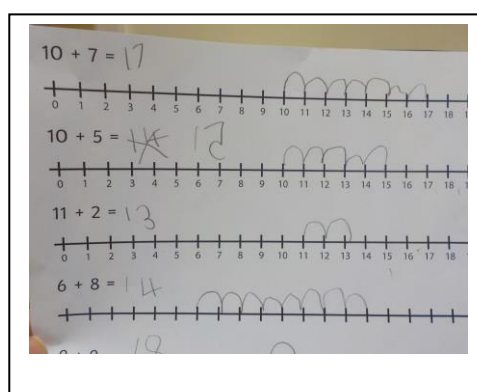
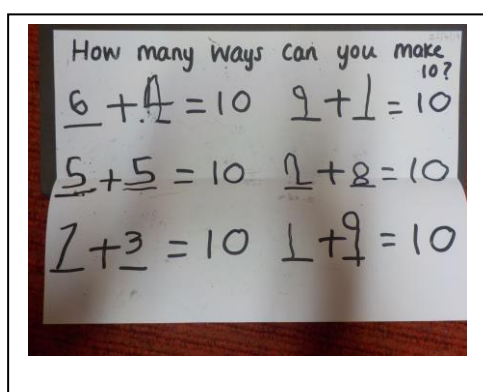
## Multi Skills Event
