# Changing Calton Credits to Space Team Points (STP)

Due to moving forward as a Restorative Practice school, we have made amendments to the Calton Credit system.

Previously, children earned points individually and spent them at the Calton Shop on things such as bouncy balls and stretchy men. Children will continue to earn points, but for their Space Team instead. These will now be referred to as Space Team Points (STP). STPs will be collected within WOW books as before, along with other achievements throughout the school day.

All previously collected Calton Credit points that the children have earned and saved will be honoured and special activities are being arranged.
